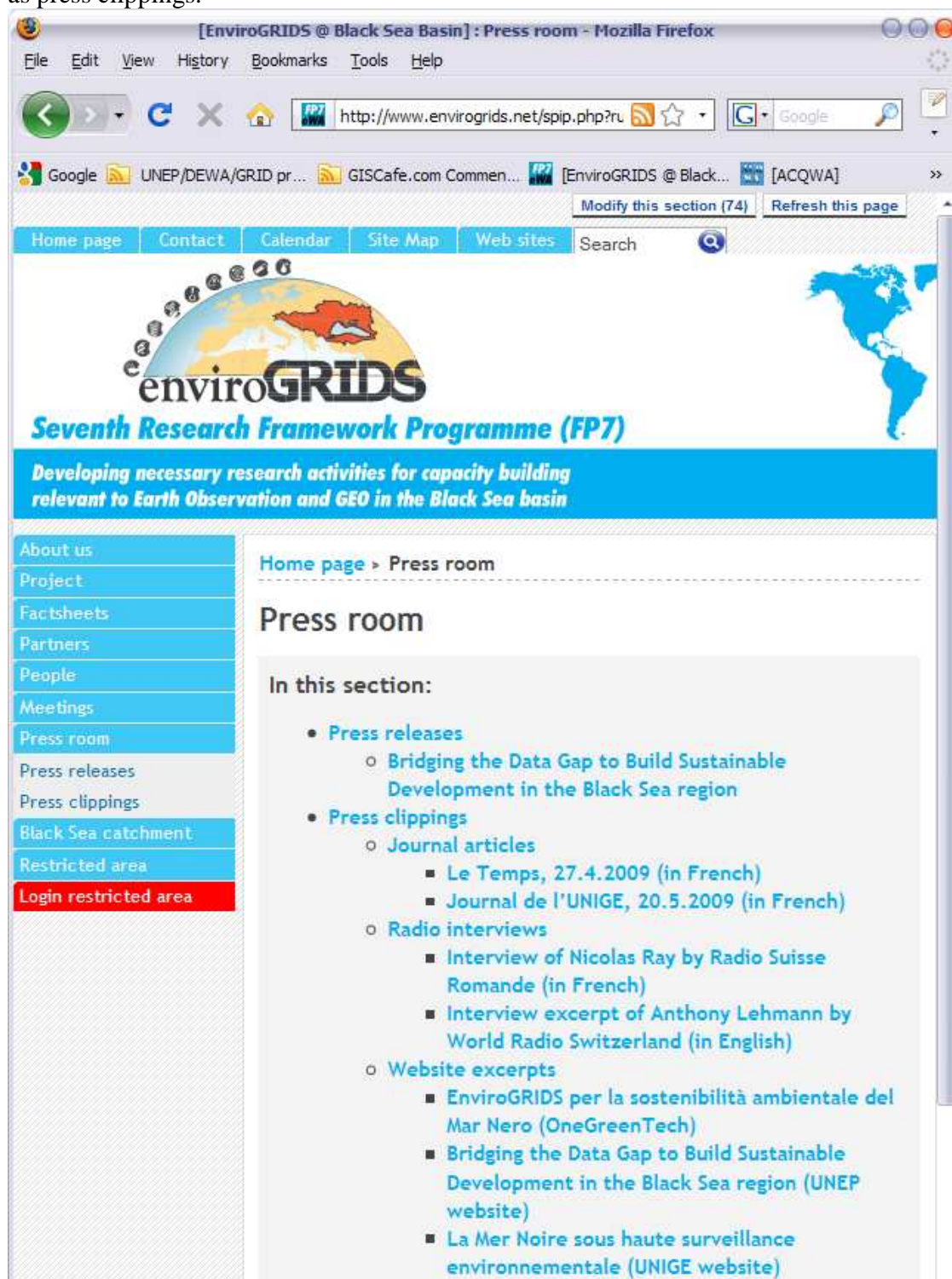

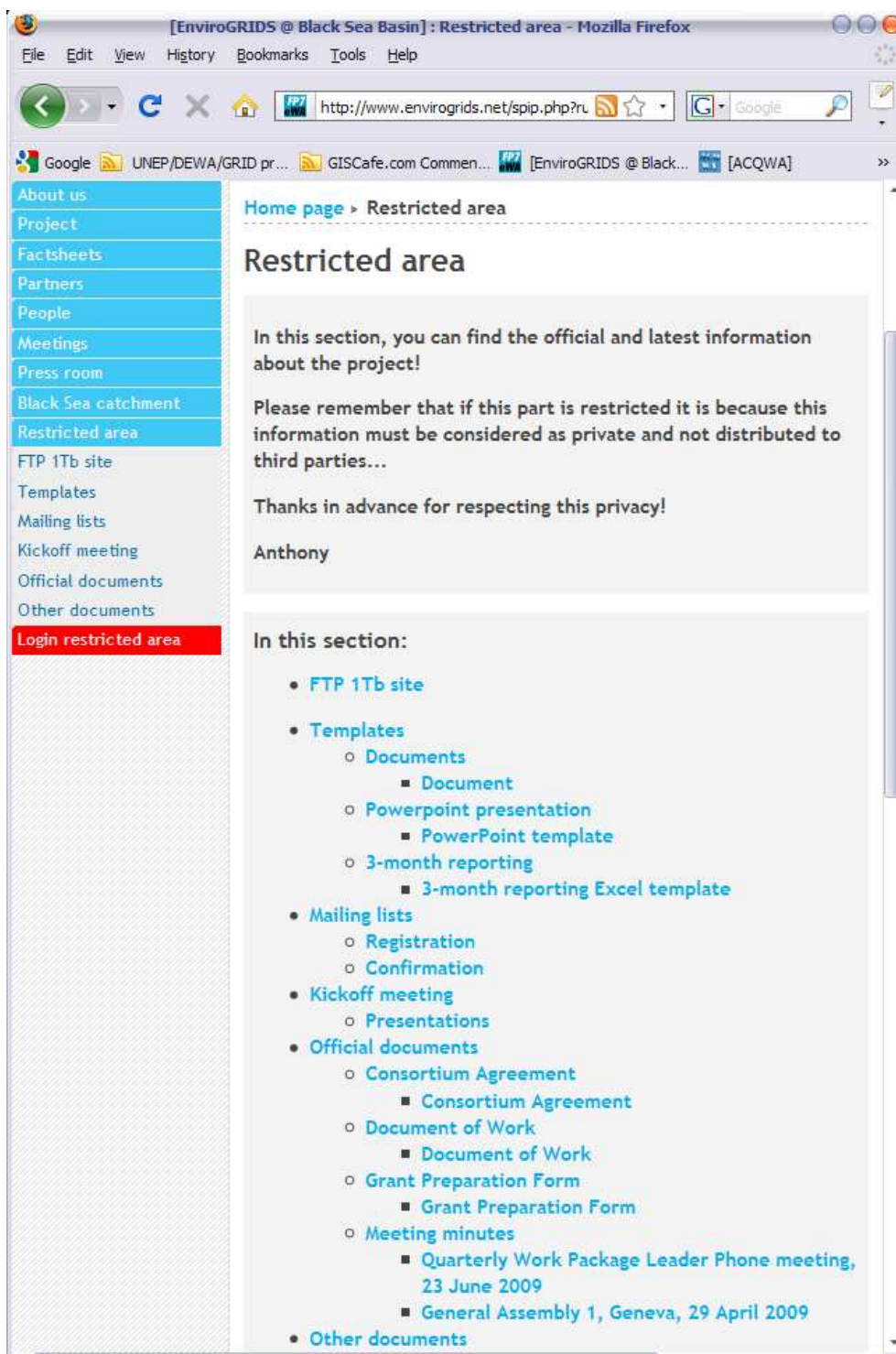

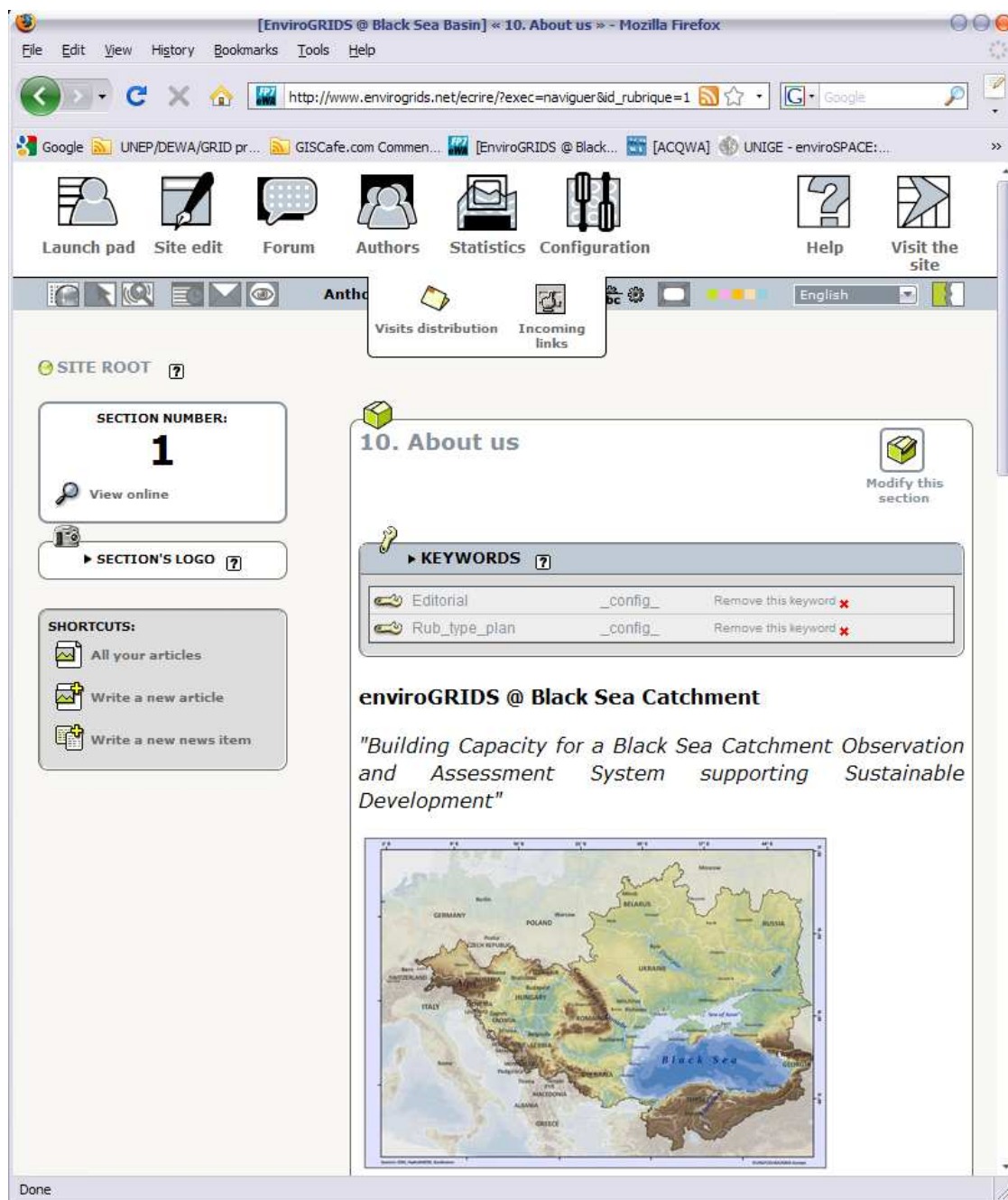

ENVIROGRIDS CONTENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

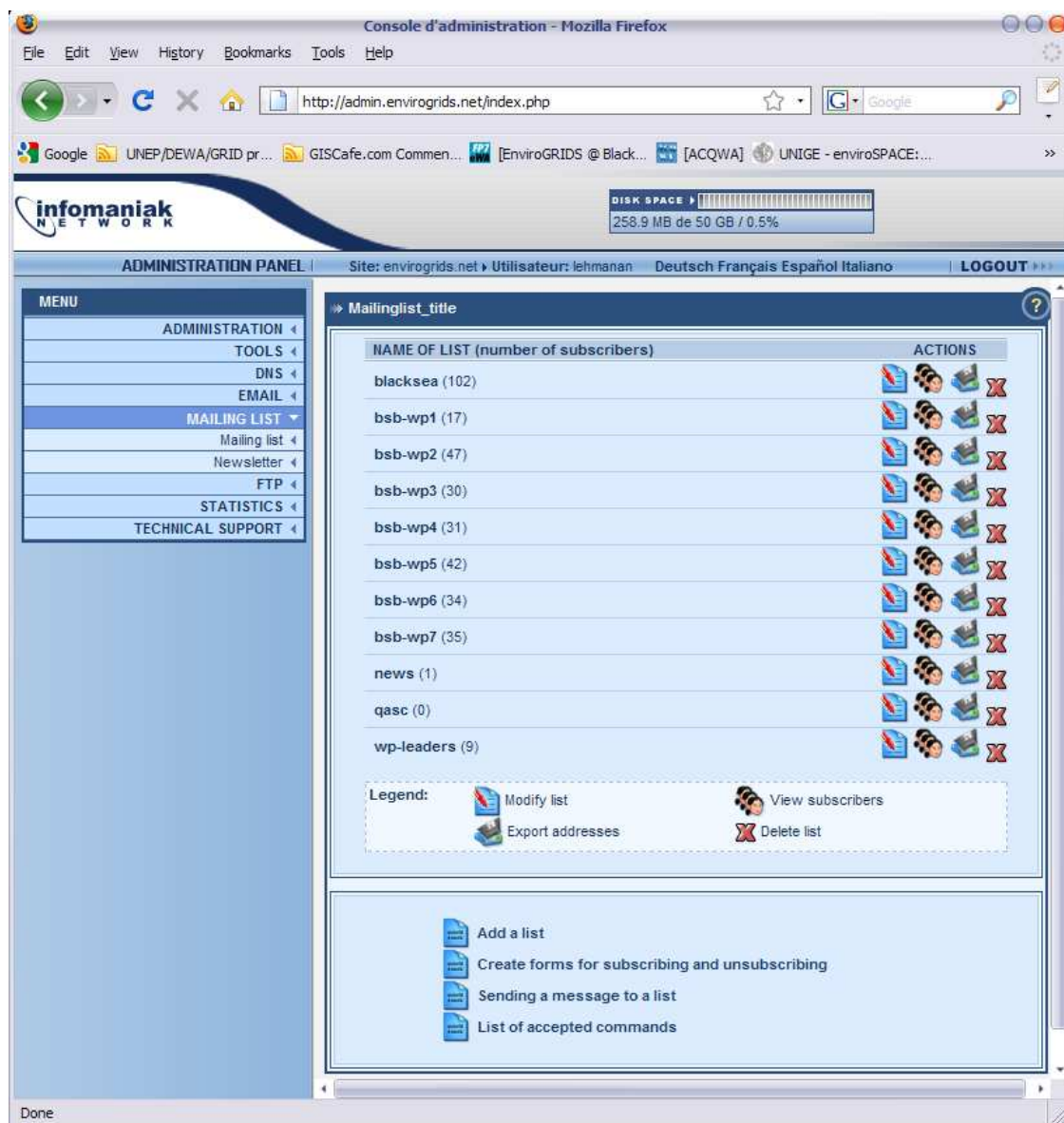
The website is created from a Content Management System (SPIP) allowing its edition by multiple editors from any place connected to the Internet.

SHARING LARGE DATA SETS BY FTP

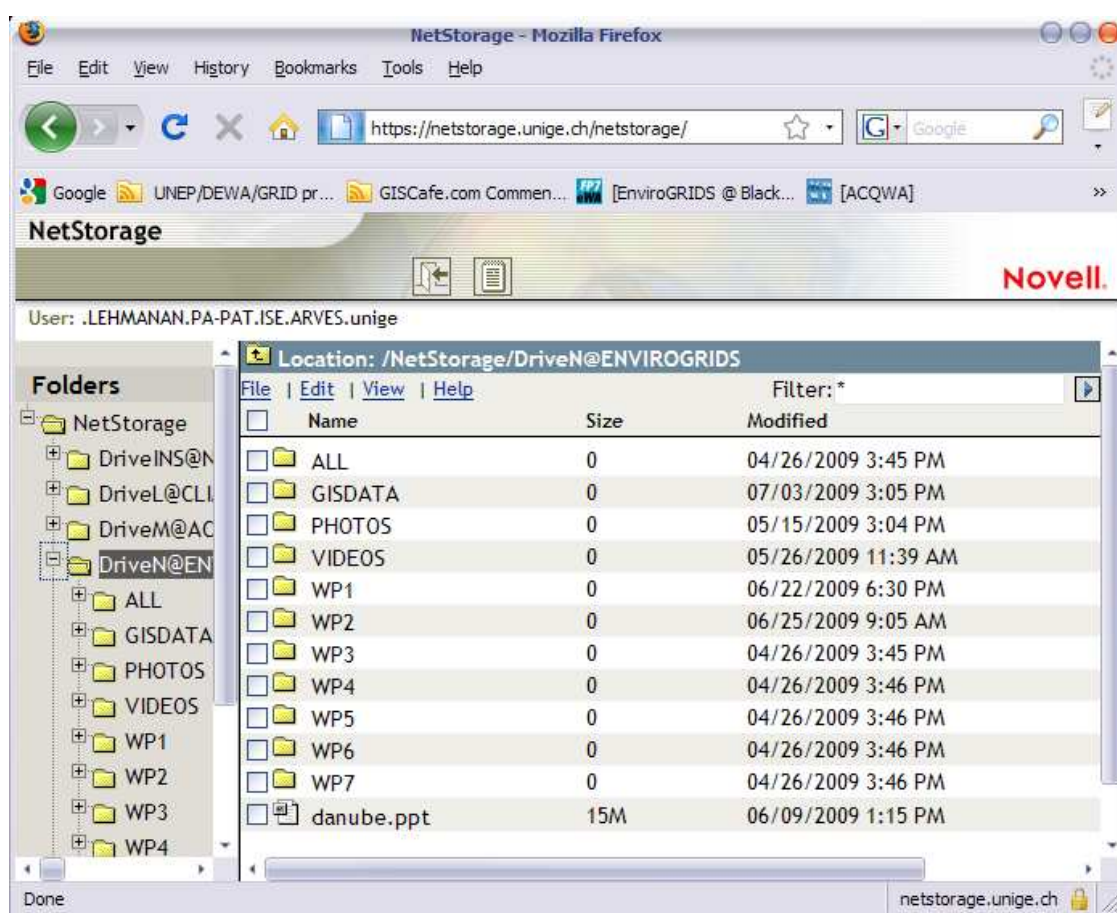
A 1 Tb FTP disk has been setup to allow the enviroGRIDS partners to share their relevant data sets (upload and download).
